PART ONE: WHAT WE BELIEVE

IN ESSENTIAL BELIEFS - WE HAVE UNITY

THE ESSENTIALS WE BELIEVE:

SCRIPTURF

1. ABOUT GOD

God is the Creator and Ruler of the universe. He has eternally existed in three persons: the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. The three are co-equal and are one God and yet He demonstrates in relationship within Himself how we, too, should submit ourselves to Him in loving trust. God is timeless, with no beginning nor end; He is omnipotent, omniscient, and omnipresent, perfect and complete, lacking nothing; unchanging in His character, ruling over all creation.

2. ABOUT JESUS CHRIST

Jesus Christ is the Son of God. He is co-equal with the Father, and all creation is created through Him. Jesus was born to a virgin, lived a sinless human life and offered Himself as the perfect sacrifice for the sins of all people by dying on a cross. He arose from the dead after three days to demonstrate His power over sin and death. He ascended to Heaven's glory and will return again someday to reign as King of Kings, and Lord of Lords.

3. ABOUT THE HOLY SPIRIT

The Holy Spirit is co-equal with the Father and the Son of God. He is present in the world to make men aware of their need for Jesus Christ. He also lives in every Christian from the moment of salvation. He provides the Christian with power for living, understanding of spiritual truth, and guidance in doing what is right. He gives every believer a spiritual gift(s) when they are saved. As Christians, we seek to live under His control daily.

4. ABOUT THE BIBLE

It is the supreme source of truth for Christian beliefs and living. Because it is inspired by God, it is the truth without any mixture of error. It reflects the background, culture, and style of its human authors while speaking with the authority of God. It is the ultimate authority for right and wrong for all people. As a church and as individuals, we therefore seek to live according to God's plan for our lives as explicitly and implicitly stated therein, applying it wisely, and in light of the Gospel, in every sphere of our existence.

5. ABOUT HUMAN BEINGS

The ultimate purpose for every human life is to glorify God and enjoy Him forever. God made humanity in the spiritual image of God; male and female; to be like Him in character. Every person has a tremendous potential for good, but human nature is inherently sinful, separating people from God and negatively impacting each individual and their relationships.

SCRIPTURF

6. ABOUT SALVATION

Salvation is God's free gift to us, but we must choose to accept it. We can never make up for our sin by self-improvement or good works. Only by trusting in Jesus Christ's finished work on the Cross as God's offer of forgiveness can anyone be saved from sin's penalty. When we turn from our self-ruled life and turn to Jesus in faith we are saved. Eternal life begins the moment one receives Jesus Christ into his life by faith.

7. ABOUT ETERNAL SECURITY

God gives us eternal life though Jesus Christ. As such, the true believer is secure in that salvation for eternity. If you have been genuinely saved, you cannot "lose" it. Salvation is maintained by the grace and power of God, not by the self-effort of the Christian. It is the grace and keeping power of God that gives us this security.

8. ABOUT ETERNITY

People were created to exist forever. We will either exist eternally separated from God by our sin, or eternally with God through His forgiveness and salvation. 9. ABOUT HUMAN SEXUALITY AND MARRIAGE

Human Sexuality - The Bible teaches that God created human sexual relations to be exercised solely within marriage. Hence, this church opposes all forms of sex outside of marriage as sin, because it is destructive spiritually, emotionally and physically to all involved.

Marriage - Marriage is a Biblical institution established by God; designed to be a picture of Christ and the Church, as clearly described in the Bible. This church recognizes that marriage always has been intended to be and always will be the uniting of one man and one woman (according to the biological sex of each at birth) in covenant commitment for a lifetime. Accordingly, this church, its pastors, staff and members, will not participate in same sex unions or similar ceremonies, nor shall its property or resources be used for such purposes.
